JOB SUMMARY

The 4 Seasons of Early Years Outreach Worker is responsible for supporting parents with individual outreach, and facilitates pre and post-natal groups. The Outreach Worker promotes and facilitates healthy pregnancies and enhance parenting capacity and early learning opportunities for supporting infants and toddlers; through an Indigenous lens.

The successful candidate will have:

- Knowledge of maternal and infant health, parenting education and concepts of early childhood education and early child development;
- Knowledge of the unique and diverse traditional practices of the Coast Salish (Hwulmuxw Mustimuxw)
- Post-secondary course work in Early Childhood Education or related field;
- Experience working with families with infant/toddlers;
- Familiarity with the community and surrounding areas;
- Knowledge of maternal and infant health, parenting education and concepts of early childhood education and early child development required;
- Good written and communication skills
- Knowledge of Microsoft office applications such as Outlook and Word;
- A clean Criminal Record Check;
- Valid driver's license

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop supportive relationships with mothers and other primary caregivers, reinforcing the value of their role in providing nurturing care;
- Introduce play-based learning activities that respond to infant/toddler's interests and developmental stage;
- Be knowledgeable about services and interventions available within the community, including referral protocols, scope of service, and criteria for participation.
